About DeLCON

It was launched in January 2009 with the 10 DBT member Institutions (presently 34 members) with a large number of high impact online journals. It is a national initiative for providing access to scholarly electronic resources including full-text and bibliographic databases in all the life science subject disciplines to DBT Institutional community. The 'DeLCON Consortium' provides current as well as archival access to more than 1171 core and peer-reviewed journals in different disciplines from 21 foreign publishers. The faculties, scientists, research scholars, students and project assistants of Institutions covered under DeLCON are the primary beneficiaries.

About NBRC:

National Brain Research Centre is the only institute in India dedicated to neuroscience research and education. Scientists and students of NBRC come from diverse academic backgrounds, including biological, computational, mathematical, physical, engineering and medical sciences, and use multidisciplinary approaches to understand the brain. Located in the foothills of the Aravali range in Manesar, Haryana, NBRC is an autonomous institute funded by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India, and is a Deemed University established in the year 1999.

How to reach the Venue :

New Delhi is the nearest airport which is 35 KM from NBRC, prepaid and radio taxis are available from airport round-the clock, or one can come upto Mahipalpur/ Palam mode situated on NH-8 which are just a couple of Kilometres from airport and take public transport/interstate buses to reach NBRC.

From Delhi/New Delhi Railway stations :

Delhi, New Delhi and Anand Vihar Railway stations are connected by Delhi Metro Rail Network the nearest metro station is IFFCO Chowk metro station. NBRC is nearly 24 KM from this metro station. Interstate and city buses are available from IFFCO Chowk/NH-8 which drops you at NSG campus, NBRC is situated adjacent to NSG campus on NH-8 and is nearly 1.5 KM from NSG campus stand.

From Gurgaon Railway Station

Take an auto to come upto Gurgaon Bus stand. Interstate and City Bus Services going towards Manesar/Dharuhera/Rewari are available from bus stand which drop you at NSG campus.

By Bus :

Frequent Interstate buses going towards Rewari, Dharuhera, Jaipur etc. from various Interstate Bus terminals in Delhi/New Delhi, Dhola Kuan, IFFCO Chowk are available which drops you at NSG Campus/Manesar.

Prepaid taxi's, Radio-taxi's and Auto-rickshaw are available from airport, railway-stations, metro stations and other important places in the NCR.
