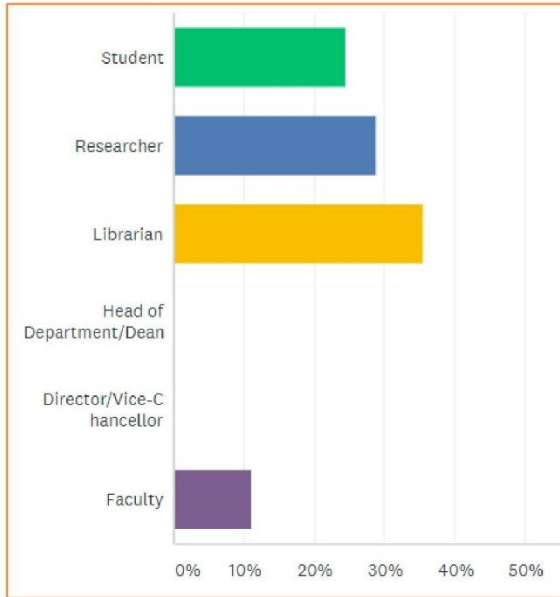
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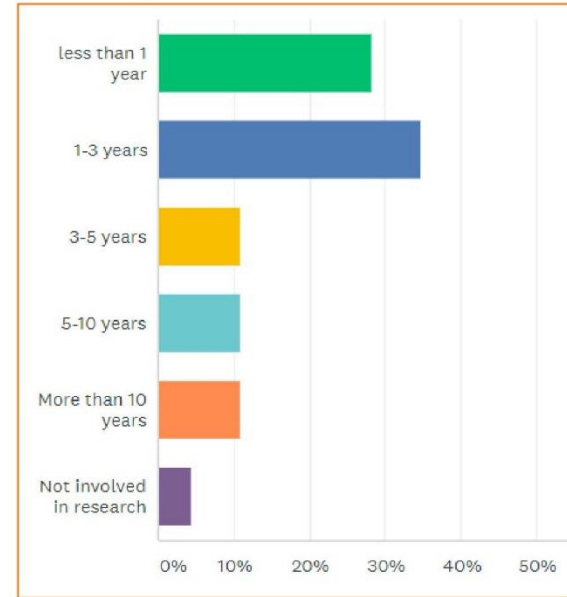


Post-Workshop Survey Results- *Participants Profile*

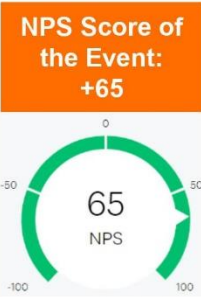
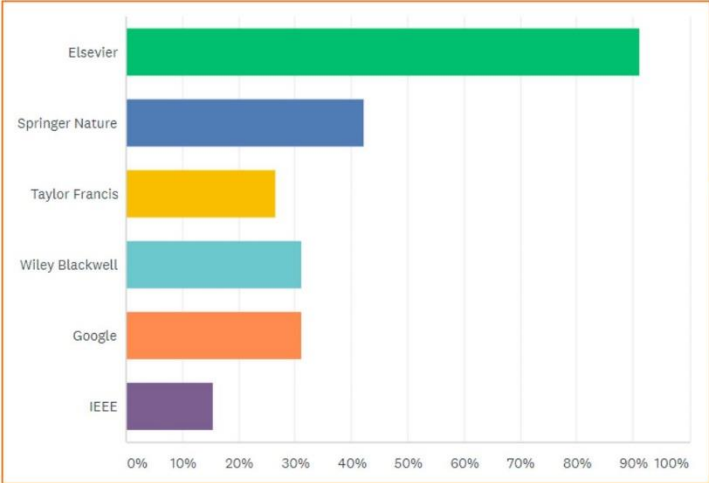


How many years have you been actively involved in research

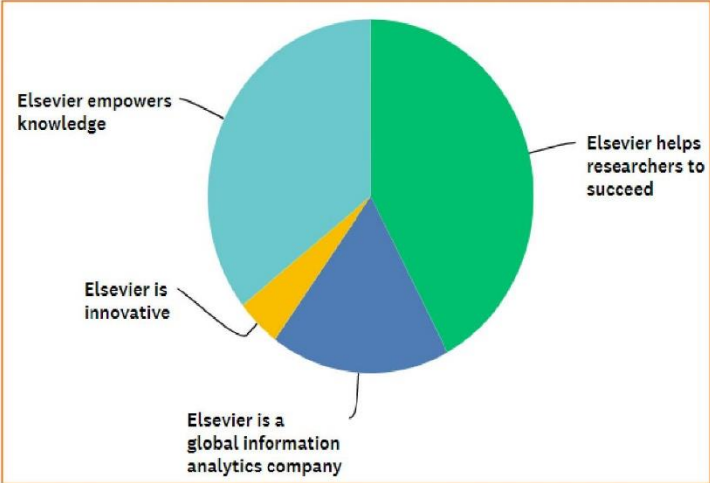


Post-Workshop Survey Results- Elsevier's Value Perception

For your scientific information requirements, who is your trusted partner?

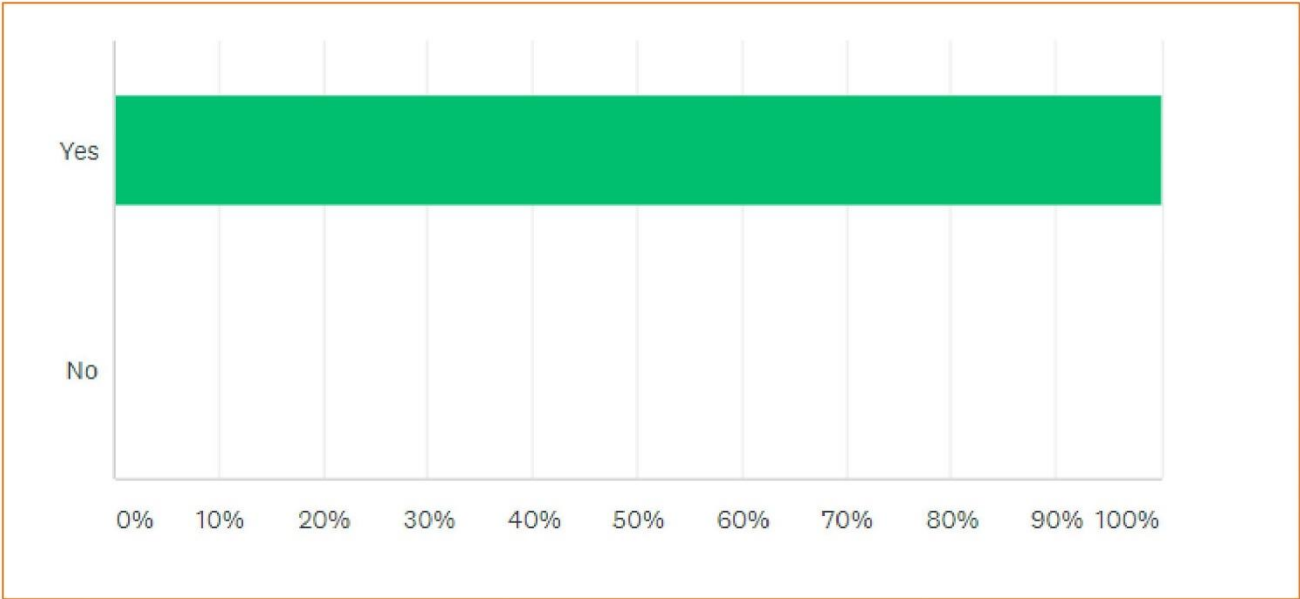


When you think of Elsevier, what comes to your mind first?



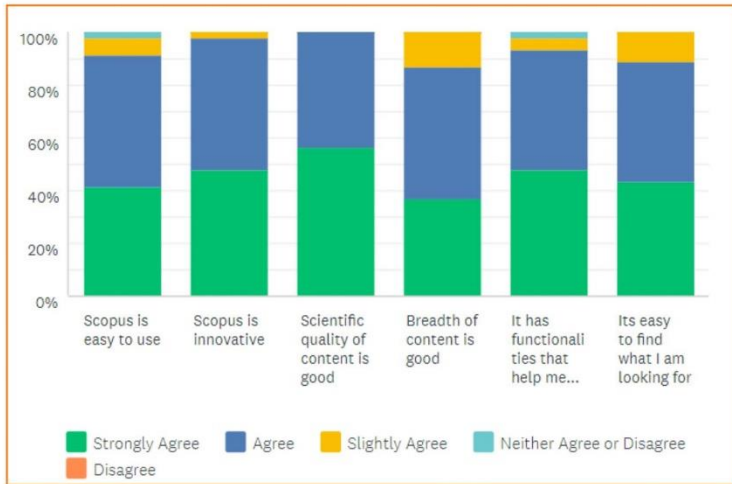
Post-Workshop Survey Results- *Relevance of Elsevier Events*

Does the training add value to your day to day research work?

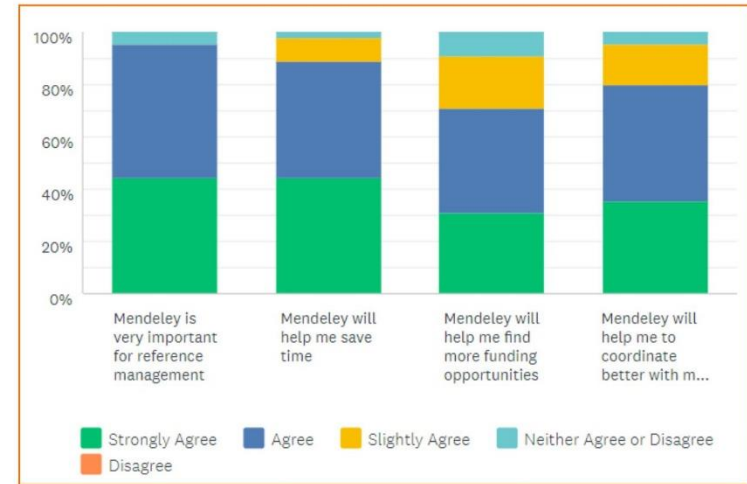

Article-level metrics in Scopus: *Compare Like with Like*

- ❑ **The Field-Weighted Citation Impact (FWCI)** score comes from the Scopus database and shows how the article's citation count compares to similar articles in the same field and timeframe.
- ❑ A score of 1.00 means the article is cited as it would be expected, greater than 1.00 the article is doing better than expected, and less than 1.00 the article is underperforming.
- ❑ Eg. FWCI of 6 indicates that the article

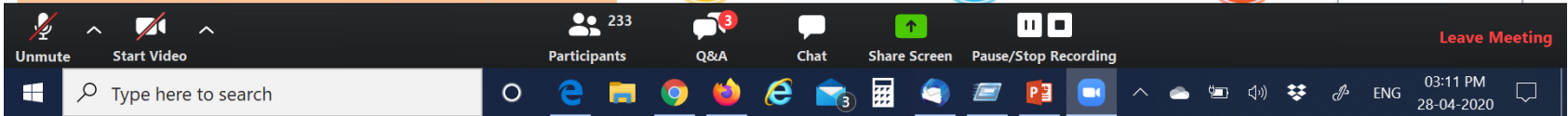

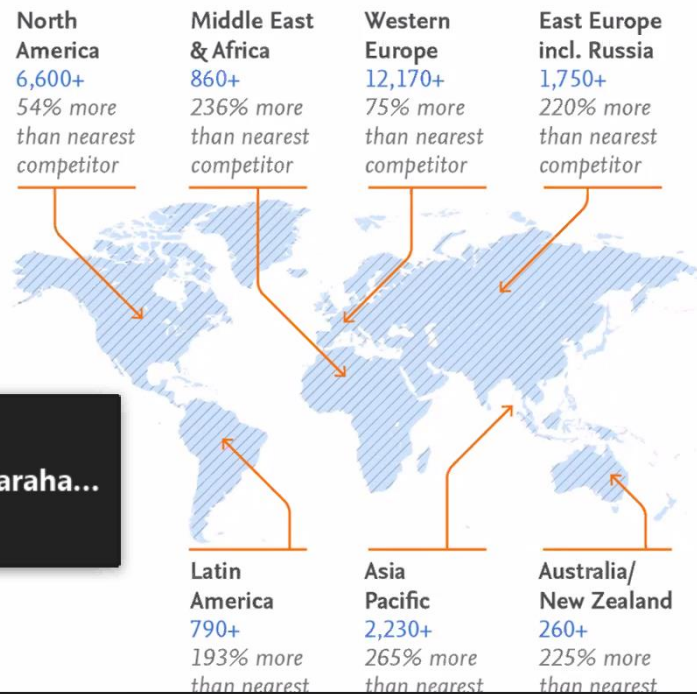
